Explanation of significant increases in the budget:
 \$125,404 or 5.27% is due to an increase in the overall city valuations from \$174M to 189M. This includes all valuation classes. \$30,000 increase is an estimate of the city's liability insurance. The increases in FICA, IPERS, and other employee benefits are due to an increase in overall wages and slight health insurance increases. At this point in the budget process, the additional \$117,989 or 3.45% is just an estimate and these amounts may be lowered before the actual 2021-2022 budget is approved.
